Open to all male members with a 15.0 handicap index or above. Bring a sharpie and a unique ball marker to this event. You don't have to win each hole; you have to survive. Shotgun start at 3:00 p.m. on June 7th, \$25 entry fee.

First Sadie Hawkins:

Fourth of July Flag Tournament:

Pick up your flag in the Golf Shop before you play. Each player gets a flag with their name and handicap attached. Tee off on #1 and plant the flag after reaching 36 strokes plus, your handicap. Whoever makes it the furthest around the golf course wins. Entry fee \$10 per person. Event will be held Saturday, July 5th. Sign up with the golf shop.

Goose River Invitational:
